BENEFIT FISH / CHICKEN FRY FOR THE CRISIS PREGNANCY CENTER OF MARYVILLE


Please mark your calendars for Friday, July 11, as we will have a benefit Fish/Chicken Fry to help raise money to place an ultrasound machine in the Crisis Pregnancy Resource Center of Maryville. As many of you know, through the state's "Meet Life" program, in conjunction with Supreme, the State Council has been placing ultrasound machines in Pregnancy Resource Centers across the state - to date, 34 machines have been placed. (Once a jurisdiction raises half of the money needed to purchase an ultrasound machine (which retails for around \$35,000) Supreme will provide the other half of the cost.) The Maryville Center is now next in line to receive one, once enough funds have been raised through state-wide Meet Life collections. This will hopefully occur sometime this summer.

We decided this was the perfect opportunity to have a benefit for the Center - first to allow the people in this area (both Catholic and non-Catholic) to support it, and also to provide it with publicity. The Center is here and ready to help women facing unexpected pregnancies.

We will run this much like our Fish Fries, except that we will be using the Parish Multipurpose Center (Gymnasium) instead of the Parish Hall. This will give us much more room for people to eat, and will allow us to set our cooker right outside of the kitchen (on the east side), so it will be more convenient to bring the freshly cooked fish and chicken into the serving area.

The menu will be much the same as our Fish Fries, except that we also be offering chicken fillets (which will be breaded in the same coating as our fish), for those who do not like fish. (Thus we will not be offering Grilled Cheese sandwiches.) And remember we will also need EVERY Knight to provide a dessert to be served that evening. We will also need Knights for food preparation, set up tables and chairs, cook fish, serving line, clean up, etc.

This is your chance to help save a baby's life, right here in Maryville. We hope you can help out with this.



CLERGY APPRECIATION DINNER

Council Scholarship Winner


