STATE CONVENTION

I am very pleased to announce that at the State Convention, our council was awarded the Service Program Award for the best "Council Activity" in the state of Missouri for our PAT Van program. Pictured below are the State Council Activities Director Mike Tesmer, Ron Mathias, Grand Knight Robert Rice, State Deputy Joe Rosenthal, Deputy Grand Knight Ken Garner, and Mike Grudzinski.



Because we won the State award, our entry will be submitted on for the Supreme award, where our submission will be judged against the other Council Activities award winners from all 50 states, DC, Canada, and Mexico. The Grand Knight of the winning entries (in each of the 6 categories) will be given a free trip to the Supreme Convention in August, which will be held in Baltimore, MD this year.

Also at this year's State Convention, Mike Grudzinski was elected as the State Secretary. Below is a picture of Mike immediately following his election.



The office of State Secretary is akin to the Financial Secretary position at the council level. This position is also like a "Deputy State Deputy," in that if something (God-forbid) would happen which incapacitates the State Deputy, the State Secretary is appointed to take over.

I promise you I will continue to do my best to work with our council, while I add additional responsibilities through my work on the State level.

EVENTS FOR 2018-2019 FRATERNAL YEAR

Please look over the calendar on the right column as this gives you an overview of what we have planned for the upcoming Fraternal Year. Some events we hope that you highlight to put into your calendar:

- Beginning in September, we will host a 24 week Video Series on Wednesday evenings to learn more about the Bible. Knights, wives, and any member of the parish will be invited to attend.
- October 7 - We will pray the rosary at our Monument to the Unborn prior to the 8:00 AM Mass
- October 12-14 - Our Drive for Persons with Developmental Disabilities will take place where we distribute Tootsie Rolls at HyVee and Walmart, the NW Homecoming Parade, and after all Masses.
- October 27 - We will have our annual Knights Mass / Memorial Mass at the Saturday 5:00 services. Prior to Mass we will pray the Rosary in remembrance of all members who have gone before us. All ministries during the Mass will be performed by Knights as well.
- January 27 - Formation & Knighthood (2nd & 3rd) Degrees at Conception Abbey. All 1st Degree members are *strongly encouraged* to go through.
- We will have 4 Lenten Fish Fries again this year - 2 for our council (set costs) and 2 benefit ones (free-will donations): Special Olympics Missouri Training for Life Campus, and Camp Quality Northwest Missouri.

- \$1,105 to Special Olympics (donations from members when paying 2018 dues)
- \$1,675 - profits from Fish Fry #2 - to Special Olympics Missouri for their Training for Life Campus
- \$2,473.32 - profits from Fish Fry #4 - to Camp Quality Northwest Missouri
- \$2,500 - total of Baby Bottle Campaign and council donation to The Source - the Pregnancy Resource Center in Maryville
- \$1,000 to the benefit for brother Knight Randy Buck, and wife Erica and their 3 children, whose house burned down over the Memorial Day weekend
- \$483 to the St. Gregory's Youth Group - to purchase Roses for Mother's Day weekend
- \$500 to St. Gregory's Kitchen for our use of it for our Fish Fries
- \$194 for new Roaster Ovens for the Parish Kitchen
- \$500 scholarship to Maryville HS graduate Amberlea Auffert, who will be attending NWMSU
- \$100 for the House of Haiti
- We shingled the Habitat for Humanity House being built in Maryville (see pictures on Page 3)
