Catechesis of the GOOD SHEPHERD

Matthew 19:14

Just like last year, we are going to ask for your support of the Catechesis of the Good Shepherd program at St. Gregory's. With your generous donations last year, we were able to fund the production of a professionally created video which explains the program in greater detail.

While this program is very important to us as part of the St. Gregory's Parish Community, a State Sponsored program called "Meet Life Phase 2" is also very important to us as well. During "Meet Life (Phase 1)" councils throughout the State raised over \$2,000,000 to help put ultrasound machines into Pregnancy Resource Centers throughout the State - including the one here in Maryville. Since Meet Life 1 ended approximately 6 years ago, ultrasound machines now need to be replaced and most importantly, the cost of paying to "upgrade" the results for searches for

"unplanned pregnancy" with Google continue to rise. The money used to market through Google puts the local PRC near the top of the search. As you are all aware, most people will click on the 1st, 2nd or 3rd link in a Google search, and those are currently being paid for by the large abortion companies.

So when you are paying your 2024 council dues, please consider adding an *additional* \$10 of which \$5.00 will to go towards the St. Gregory's CGS program and \$5.00 will be given to the Meet Life 2 program.

We have maintained our \$30 annual dues rate for quite a few years now, which is hopefully not too big of a financial burden for anyone. Please note that the \$30 we ask for INCLUDES a \$7.50 donation to the RIB program, and also covers State and Supreme Per Capita totals.

- \$50 to Conception Abbey in memory of Fr. Reginald Sander and another \$50 in memory of Jason Barbosa.
- * We paid \$260 to purchase 1/2 of a table which allowed four teachers to attend the PTO Auction.
- * We provided two 5-packs of tickets to our council fish fries for the PTO Auction.
- We donated \$500 to go towards a retreat at Conception Abbey for 8th Graders at St. Gregory's for next year.
